 - Article 1 specifies which firms are required to be licensed in the fertilizer, soil amelioration and culture substrates sector.
 - Articles 2, 6, and 7 and Annex II set forth the mandatory health standards for all animal by-products used in the manufacture of organic fertilizers.
 - Articles 3, 4 and 5 lay down the following labelling requirement: "Contains animal protein. Prohibited for use on grassland".

Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:

Some organic fertilizers are made from animal by-products; moreover, survival in the soil of agents responsible for transmissible spongiform encephalopathy (TSE) cannot be excluded; it is therefore necessary to specify the sanitary rules applicable to such products in order to control the spread of the disease.
