Description of content: It establishes the criteria to procedures to assess conformity and security, in order to be acquainted with the Conformity Assessment Program for Toys through the certification mechanism and provisions settled by the Technical Regulation aimed at preventing consumption accidents. This Ordinance N°. 489 revokes Ordinance 133, 15 August 2003, and Ordinance 49, 13 February 2008; issued by Inmetro, from 6 November 2014. And will revokes Ordinance 108, 13 Jun 2005; Ordinance 369, 27 September 2007; Ordinance 321, 29 October 2009; Ordinance 152, 30 April 2010; Ordinance 377, 28 September 2010, and Ordinance 117, 10 March 2011, issued by Inmetro, from 6 November 2018.
