- **6. Description of content** Draft Mercosur Resolution proposing the mandatory nutritional labelling for packaged food. It establishes that the nutritional labelling must contain information on the total caloric value, protein, carbohydrate, fat, saturated fat, fibre, trans fatty acid and sodium contents.

This resolution will be implemented in a two step approach: from 31 July 2005 on, the labelling must contain information on caloric value, protein, carbohydrate, fat and fibre contents. From 31 July 2007 on, information on saturated fat, trans fatty acid and sodium contents in the labelling will be mandatory.

It also revokes Mercosur Resolution number 18/94 (Resolução GMC número 18/94), after 31 July 2005.
