## NOTIFICATION

### *Addendum*

The following communication, dated 9 November 2015, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the United States of America.

---

TITLE: Radio Frequency Devices, FCC Form 740 Temporary Suspension

AGENCY: Federal Communications Commission

ACTION: Final rule; temporary suspension

SUMMARY: This document temporarily waives the requirements of the Commission's rules that govern the submission of information associated with FCC Form 740 concerning imported Radio Frequency (RF) devices. U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is implementing a new electronic filing system which is scheduled to become fully operational by December 2016. In light of steps taken related to the transition to the new CBP system, parties importing RF devices will lose the ability to electronically file the required FCC information. The Commission does not believe that it would serve the public interest to establish an alternative means for importers to submit this information with us during the pendency of the rulemaking.
